1. What were the 4 main timeframes in the book?
2. Which character did you like best and why?
3. Share a favorite quote from the book. Why did this quote stand out?
4. Which character experienced the most change over the course of the story? Which character do you wish had changed more?
5. Why do you think Jean wrapped the secret message around the bobbin? We later learn that Kathleen finds Jean's secret message, which reads, "We have to leave. There is no work here for Donald. Wish us luck, Jean."
6. Kathleen writes all of her sewing tasks in a notebook, as well as how much she was paid and who it was for. Why do you think that is?
7. What hurdles does Fred have to go through to learn how to sew?
8. The sewing machine seems to save each character when they appear to be lost. How so?
